1 FORTHCOMING PLANNING INQUIRIES AND HEARINGS

This list includes forthcoming inquiries and hearings for all three Areas which have now been arranged. Unless otherwise indicated, they will be held in the Civic Suite at the Gibson Building and will last one day. All hearings and inquiries commence at 10.00 hours on the first day.

There are also a number of other outstanding appeals for which hearing/inquiry dates have not yet been allocated. It is now the practice of the Planning Inspectorate not to list new cases for hearing more than three months in advance.

1.1 Site: Land south east of Orchard House, London Road, Hildenborough

Details: Construction of farmhouse in existing farmyard

Date: Hearing – 03 August 2011 (Tonbridge Castle)

1.2 Site: The Hop Farm, Maidstone Road, Paddock Wood

Details: Appeals against (1) Refusal of planning permission for the creation of a miniature driving school including construction of a hard surface track with raised kerb stones, street furniture and timber post fencing and associated one storey pitched roof building with ornamental petrol pumps. (2) Refusal of planning permission for the erection of a marguee structure with hard surface base and related drainage works for a temporary period of 5 years. (3) An enforcement notice – the erection of a marguee structure with a hard surface base. (4) An enforcement notice – creation of a miniature driving school. (5) An enforcement notice - the erection of children's play equipment. (6) An enforcement notice - the erection of a red circus tent. (7) An enforcement notice – construction of an enclosure or arena. (8) An enforcement notice – the erection of children's fairground rides. (9) An enforcement notice - the creation of a hardstanding. (10) A listed building enforcement notice –without listed building consent the alterations of a listed building by attaching to the front elevation a children's climbing frame and removing part of balustrade to the greenstage.
