1 STATEMENT ON INTERNAL CONTROL FOR YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2007

This report presents the Statement on Internal Control for the year ended 31 March 2007 to be certified by both the Leader of the Council and the Chief Executive for inclusion in the Council's 2006/07 Statement of Accounts for endorsement.

1.1 Introduction

1.1.1 The Statement on Internal Control (SIC) forms part of the Council's Statement of Accounts. This Committee has responsibility for overseeing the production of the authority's Statement on Internal Control and for recommending its adoption.

1.2 The Statement on Internal Control

- 1.2.1 The Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy (CIPFA) recommend that the most senior Member (Leader of the Council) and Officer (Chief Executive) of the Council certify the Statement on Internal Control. The purpose of the Statement is to assess and demonstrate that there is a sound system of internal control.
- 1.2.2 The Use of Resources Assessment that feeds into the Comprehensive Performance Assessment stipulates (CPA) that:
 - "An appropriate member group has responsibility for review and approval of the SIC and consider it separately from the accounts".
- 1.2.3 The Statement on Internal Control for the year ended 31 March 2007 is attached at **[ANNEX 1]**.
