# 1 TONBRIDGE RACECOURSE – FLOODLIGHTING

#### Summary

This report brings forward a Capital Plan evaluation for the provision of floodlighting at Tonbridge Racecourse Sportsground.

#### 1.1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 A number of requests have been received from young people, the Police and Local Members to floodlight the teenage facilities at Tonbridge Racecourse Sportsground to extend their use through the winter months. These facilities include the skate park, ball court and tennis courts.
- 1.1.2 The provision of floodlighting was considered by Members of the Leisure and Arts Advisory Board on the 28 February 2012 where it was recommended (Decision D120029MEM) that a Capital Plan evaluation be reported to the next meeting of the Finance and Property Advisory Board. The full evaluation can be found at [Annex 1].

- 1.3.1 The cost of the capital scheme is being met in full through external funding including contributions from the Local Strategic Partnership, Police and Kent County Council Local Members. - 1.3.2 There will be a Capital Renewals impact of the scheme of £1,500 per annum, and a revenue impact of £1,000 per annum to cover electrical/maintenance costs.
