1 <u>ECONOMIC UPDATE – FEDERATION OF SMALL BUSINESSES</u>

To receive a presentation from the FSB on economic issues affecting small businesses in the area.

1.1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 The economy of the Borough, and of the wider West Kent area, is dominated by small businesses. Over 85% of businesses in the Borough employ less than five people. From time to time, the Federation of Small Businesses, the main representation body for this important sector, has been invited to meetings of the former Community Development Advisory Board to provide an update on their work and a summary of the key issues that small businesses are having to deal with.
