**1 VALLEY OF VISIONS**

**Summary**

**This report updates Members on progress with the Heritage Lottery Funded (HLF) 'Valley of Visions' project.**

**1.1 Background**

1.1.1 The Valley of Visions Landscape Partnership Scheme became operational at the beginning of December 2007. It is a three year scheme with a budget of £2.5 million with the aim of conserving and enhancing the Medway Gap's heritage landscapes and biodiversity; improving physical and intellectual access to them; and engaging local landowners, communities and visitors sustainably in their exploration, interpretation and long-term care.

1.1.2 Some £1.8m of funding is provided by the Heritage Lottery Fund with the remaining £700K provided by a number of other organisations including a contribution from the Borough Council. The delivery of the scheme is undertaken in the area known as the Medway Gap within the local authority areas of both Medway and Tonbridge & Malling.
