Priority 2: Tackle workless and promote employment	Jobcentre Plus/The Beat Project /Russet Homes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Address the amount of people in long term and short term unemployment and create more opportunities for those who have trouble engaging ▶ Develop and introduce new services to help locals engage with work, education or training ▶ Promote and develop the Job Club for local residents
Priority 3: Elderly People/Other Isolated Groups	The Beat Project, TBC, Age UK, Ton School, Russet Homes, Platform 51	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Identify and engage older residents who are vulnerable or isolated inviting them to the coffee mornings. ▶ Develop inter-generational projects with young people ▶ Develop existing elderly persons services and signpost people to them ▶ Identify local volunteers to support work with elderly residents including young people ▶ Develop, publish and distribute a leaflet providing updated information to families, the elderly and other residents on local services
Priority 4: Promoting Good Health and Well-Being	The Beat Project, Healthy Living Co-ordinator (TMBC), Other Agencies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Promote available community health support and courses, and signpost to those most in need locally. ▶ Hold a community engagement event in 2013
