GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

To improve the environment/street scene of the borough by deterring defacement by litter, dog fouling, fly tips and graffiti by the use of appropriate enforcement action.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Carry out patrols to detect instances of littering, dog fouling, fly-tipping and defacement by graffiti.
- 2. Investigate complaints/notifications of fly-tipping and graffiti.
- 3. Enforce relevant provisions of the duty of care in relation to waste transport and disposal.
- 4. Institute enforcement action, including issuing fixed penalty notices and preparing cases for prosecution, in accordance with the EHHS Enforcement Policy.
- 5. Prepare reports/statements of alleged offences for consideration for legal proceedings. Attend court to give evidence.
- 6. Maintain records of activity, prepare reports and performance statistics.
- 7. Develop and maintain effective liaison with officers of the council, other agencies (e.g. PCSOs, community wardens), contractors etc.
- 8. Contribute to publicity and education/promotion initiatives intended to deter environmental crime
- 9. Undertake any other related duties as directed.

This job description has been prepared as a working document to identify the main areas of responsibility of the post. It is not intended to be a definitive statement of the duties of the post nor specifically to exclude any task which the post-holder might reasonably be required to undertake.
