2 PARISH COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVES ON TOWN AND PARISH COUNCILS STANDARDS SUB-COMMITTEE

Summary

To report arrangements for filling a vacancy amongst the town/parish representatives on this Sub-Committee.

2.1 Introduction

- 2.1.1 Under the Council's Constitution the Council took advantage of the provisions contained in the Part 3 of the Local Government Act 2000. This enables the Council to set up a Sub-Committee of the Standards Committee to deal with matters relating to town and parish councils. The members of the sub-committee are the two independent members and five representatives selected by the town/parish councils from amongst serving town/parish councillors.
- 2.1.2 Earlier this year a vacancy arose amongst the town/parish council representatives when Mrs Lesley Brown ceased to be a member of Wrotham Parish Council. Following the agreed procedure, I invited all of the town/parish councils to submit nominations for membership.
- 2.1.3 At the close of nominations, I had received only one nomination, Councillor David Storey, Chairman of Ryarsh Parish Council and, as a result, it has not been necessary to hold a ballot. A copy of Mr Storey's personal profile is contained in **[]Annex 2]** to this report.
