1 POLITICAL BALANCE ARRANGEMENTS FOR COMMITTEES

- 1.1.1 Under section 15 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 (duty to allocate seats to political groups) and the Local Government (Committees and Political Groups) Regulations 1990, the Council is required to review the size and composition of any of its committees and sub-committees to which those provisions apply at the annual meeting of the Council.
- 1.1.2 Following the recent election, the number of seats held by each of the political parties is as follows:

Conservative 46 Liberal Democrat 7

1.1.3 The Council is required to determine the size and composition of its committees so as to reflect this political balance and, in consequence, it is necessary for those committees to be composed within the following options:
