2 <u>MEMBERSHIP OF THE TOWN AND PARISH COUNCILS</u> <u>STANDARDS SUB-COMMITTEE</u>

2.1 Introduction

- 2.1.1 I reported to the last meeting of the Council that six parish council representatives had been nominated to the Town and Parish Councils Standards Sub-Committee, meaning that there were still six vacancies.
- 2.1.2 Following the matter being raised at the Parish Partnership Panel, a further two nominations have been received, namely those of Mr Michael Corfe (West Peckham Parish Council) and Mr Jon Regan (Mereworth Parish Council).
- 2.1.3 Even with these nominations, there still remain four vacancies. It is noted that the preponderance of members come from the north and east of the Borough and that all are men, although about half of parish councillors are women. It might be considered appropriate for those areas under represented to be encouraged to appoint representatives
