##### **1 APPOINTMENTS TO OUTSIDE BODIES**

**This report considers the reappointment of a Trustee of the Hospital of the Holy Trinity, Aylesford and Town Wardens of the Tonbridge Town Lands and Richard Mylls Charity.**

##### **1.1 Introduction**

- 1.1.1 The term of office of Councillor P Homewood as one of the Trustees appointed by the Council to the Hospital of the Holy Trinity, Aylesford has recently expired. He has indicated that he is willing to continue in this post and the Council has been invited to reappoint him for a further four year term.
- 1.1.2 The terms of office of Miss J Browne, Mr D Davis and Mr J Parish as Town Wardens of the Tonbridge Town Lands and Richard Mylls Charity are due to expire in October 2008. Miss Browne and Mr Davis are willing to be reappointed but Mr Parish does not wish to serve for a further term. The Charity accordingly invites the Council to reappoint the former and consider the appointment of a replacement for Mr Parish. Whilst Town Wardens may be, but need not be, a member of the Council, the Charity has expressed a preference for an experienced current Councillor representing a Tonbridge ward.
