1 GAMBLING ACT 2005: DRAFT STATEMENT OF LICENSING POLICY

Summary

The purpose of this report is to recommend that the Council adopt a Gambling Policy Statement based upon the Kent Model following the completion of the consultation process.

1.1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 At the last meeting of the Licensing and Appeals Committee on 11 March 2010, following the consultation process, the adoption of the Kent Model draft Statement of Licensing Policy was recommended.

- 1.1.3 As a result there is no impediment to the adoption of the policy statement.
