1 PETITIONS SUBMITTED TO KENT HIGHWAY SERVICES

Summary

A report to make the Board aware of petitions received since the last meeting.

- 1.1 The Ridgeway Pedestrian Crossing
- 1.1.1 A petition has been submitted by some 56 residents, lead by Dr Brierley of Thorpe Avenue. It seeks urgent action to improve highway safety along the Ridgeway, Tonbridge such as speed reducing humps, safety cameras, pedestrian crossing or whatever action is deemed most appropriate. [Annex 1]
- 1.1.2 The need for a crossing at the location described in the petition has already been reflected in the running list of potential future schemes considered by the Board at the March and June meetings earlier this year. The petition provides additional evidence to support the need for a crossing at this location and will help in prioritising action to respond to the concerns raised.
