Scheme Title	Ward	Description
Station Road near Station upgrade of existing pedestrian island to controlled crossing	Aylesford	Upgrade of the recently installed pedestrian island to a controlled crossing to support Safer Routes to School in the area and Improve safety of pedestrians especially train commuters and school children during peak times.
Cage Green Area Safer Routes to School (A227 Shipbourne Road / The Ridgeway)	Trench	Pedestrian crossing improvements on the A227 Shipbourne Road near Cage Green Road and The Ridgeway near Penruddocke House to assist pupils going to the local schools and elderly residents walking in the area. To improve the safety of walking to school and thereby encouraging more pupils to walk to the local school and relieve congestion in the local area.
Tonbridge School Safer Routes to School Scheme	Castle	Cycle link from B245 London Road to Welland Road (Tonbridge School) & crossing in the vicinity of Dry Hill Park Road, Tonbridge on the B245 in support Safer Routes to School in the area. To provide a safer and more alternative route for cyclists and pedestrians to Tonbridge School other than the A227.
Improvements to footway / traffic calming between Birling & Ryarsh	Downs	Modifications required to existing traffic calming to be more pedestrian friendly and therefore encouraging more walking especially to local school. To encourage more walking in the village especially to the local school.
A229 Bluebell Hill bus stop protection scheme	Bluebell Hill and Walderslade	Installation of a crash barrier to protect people waiting for the bus. To protect passengers & bus stop infrastructure.
Leybourne Way, New Hythe footway extension	Larkfield North	Extension of the existing footway on the northern side of Leybourne Way to provide a local link to the Railway Station, local pub and general New Hythe area. To encourage walking by improving footway and making walking safer and more attractive.
