LA HACKNEY CARRIAGE DRIVERS - BADGE NUMBERS 788, 491 09/013 AND 1264

The Panel considered whether the holders of Hackney Carriage Driver Badge Numbers 788, 491 and 1264 were fit and proper persons to continue holding licences. These cases had been brought before the Panel following an incident in Tonbridge where two of the Council's Civil Enforcement Officers had felt threatened after issuing fixed penalty notices for illegal parking.
