APPLICATION FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGE DRIVER'S LICENCE (Reason: LGA 1972 Sch 12A Para 1 - Information relating to an individual)

LA APPLICATION FOR PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S LICENCE 09/040 (Reason: LGA 1972 Sch 12A Para 1 - Information relating to an individual)

The Central Services Director submitted details of an application for a Private Hire Driver's Licence received from a former holder of a dual hackney carriage and private hire driver's licence which had expired on 20 April 2008. Members were reminded that the applicant had previously appeared before the Panel on 6 December 2007 and on 10 November 2008. The Panel was advised of information revealed under the Criminal Record Bureau check and it gave careful consideration to the oral statement made by the applicant.

RESOLVED: That the applicant was a fit and proper person to hold a Private Hire Driver's Licence and would, therefore, be granted said licence subject to

- (1) the applicant serving a one year probationary period from the date of issue of the licence;
- (2) any infringements of the licence during the probationary period being referred to the Licensing and Appeals Committee sitting as a Panel for review; and
- (3) any future application for a Hackney Carriage Driver's Licence be considered on merit.
