LA APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE – 09/053 KEBAB EXPRESS, 6 QUARRY HILL PARADE, TONBRIDGE

The Panel gave consideration to an application made by Mr Y Bedir and Mrs F Bedir for a variation of the premises licence for Kebab Express, 6 Quarry Hill Parade, Tonbridge to extend the hours of operation for late night refreshment only. The notice of the application had been displayed at the premises and advertised in a local newspaper and the Panel was advised that two representations had been received during the statutory period.

The Panel heard from Ms J Edwards, agent for the applicant and from the Director of Health and Housing. Having considered very carefully the application and taken into account the issues set out in the report to the Licensing and Appeals Committee, sitting as a Panel it was

RESOLVED: That the Variation of Premises Licence be granted as applied for subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. a sign or written notice will be displayed at all times on or outside the premises, or at the entrance indicating the hours in which the premises are open to the public;
- 2. all instances of Crime and Disorder will be reported to the police as soon as reasonably practicable;
- 3. a minimum of one written notice to be prominently displayed requesting customers leave the premises and area quietly; and

4. the staff are to make regular and frequent sweeps of the area within the immediate vicinity of the shop front to ensure littering, associated with these premises, is kept to a minimum.

The reasons given for imposing the above conditions were the prevention of crime and disorder and the prevention of public nuisance.
