

ANNEX 2

The last meeting of the councils licensing committee agreed to a new fare tariff scheduled to come into force in the next couple of weeks. This suggests a 10p increase in the flag rate for 0.75 of a mile to £2.90. The next mile will be £2.32 and after that will be £2.26. Currently we get £2.21 per mile so this is only a 5p per mile increase in the rate, less than the 2.5% increase in VAT that will be introduced in the New Year. There is no increase in Waiting Time and Time and Distance charging has also been refused.
