10/049** **APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE IN
RESPECT OF MORRISONS, NEW HYTHE LANE, LARKFIELD**

The Panel gave consideration to an application by Wm Morrisons Supermarkets plc for the variation of the premises licence in respect of Morrisons, New Hythe Lane, Larkfield. The application sought to vary the permitted hours during which alcohol may be sold for consumption off the premises, together with a corresponding increase in the permitted opening hours.

Notice of the application had been displayed on the premises and in a local newspaper and the Panel was advised that two representations had been received during the statutory period.

The Panel heard from Councillor D Thornewell on behalf of local residents Mr D Brooman and Mrs J Brooman; the solicitor acting for Morrisons Plc and the Estates Manager representing the Licensing Authority.

Having considered very carefully the application for the variation of the premises licence in respect of Morrisons, New Hythe Lane, Larkfield, the representations made by all parties and the issues set out in the report to the Licensing and Appeals Committee, sitting as a Panel, Members were satisfied that the concerns raised had been addressed.

It was therefore decided to grant the variation of the Premises Licence as applied for.

The Panel believed that the granting of this variation of the Premises

Licence was made in accordance with the objectives contained in the Licensing Act 2003 and the Licensing Policy of Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council.
