



The Home Office is responsible for compiling a National Statistics bulletin on alcohol and late night refreshment under the Licensing Act 2003. The Department for Culture, Media and Sport retain policy responsibility for entertainment.

This year's exercise is consistent with the previous questionnaire *(see link below)*, following the first Licensing Act 2003 data collection exercise in 2006/07. However some lines have been removed as part of the Home Office commitment to reduce the burden on Local Authorities in completing statistical returns. Also new questions have been added to assess changes to the licensing regime. The information will continue to inform our ongoing monitoring of the licensing regime, and provide evidence for future collections (e.g. which questions we will continue to ask, the frequency of the collection etc.). The guidance and help information have been expanded this year. Please refer to this information if in any doubt about how to respond to a particular question.
