1 HERITAGE OPEN DAYS 2005

Summary

This report informs the Panel of the progress being made towards the above event.

1.1 Background

1.1.1 The Heritage Open Days scheme is a national event co-ordinated by The Civic Trust and supported by English Heritage. The aim of the scheme is to celebrate England's architecture and culture. It also offers the public free access to buildings of interest, which normally charge an admission fee. Across the borough properties will be opening their doors to the public during the weekend of Saturday 10 and Sunday 11 September 2005.

1.2 Venues

1.2.1 To date 23 venues across the borough have signed up to this year's scheme. The promotion of the event has been greatly helped by enthusiastic support and assistance of parish councils. There are five properties listed from West Malling, including St Mary's Abbey, St Leonards Tower and Pilsdon at the Malling Community. Aylesford is well represented with submissions from Preston Hall and The Friars. Village walks are also being organised in Hadlow, Offham and Wateringbury. Garden centres such as Broadview and Downderry Nursery will also be participating in this year's event.

1.3 Tours

1.3.1 Two new inclusions in this year's event are guided tours of Haysden Country Park and Leybourne Lakes. The tours at both the Country Parks will take place on Saturday 10 September (time to be confirmed). Places on these tours will be limited to 20 and bookable through the Tourist Information Centre at Tonbridge Castle. The Tourist Information Centre will also be pre booking tours for St Mary's Abbey and The Leigh Barrier. Tonbridge Castle will also be open on Sunday 11 September from 10.30pm—4pm where partial tours of the Gatehouse will be available to the public. Live music will be provided by Wadhurst Brass Band from

- 2pm–4pm and various exhibitions by Tonbridge's Art Group and Camera Club will be on display in the Council Chamber.
- 1.3.2 Many churches have also signed up to the event including St Michael's, East Peckham, St Mary the Virgin, West Malling and the Parish Church of Tonbridge; St Peter & St Paul. For a full list including dates and opening times list see [Annex 1].
- 1.3.3 Bernard Tyson, Chairman of the Historical Society in West Malling has been very helpful this year in co-ordinating participating properties in this year's event.

1.3.4 Advertising

- 1.3.5 A leaflet listing all participants, opening dates and times will be available from the Tourist Information Centre towards the end of July. Copies of the leaflet will be sent to all parish councils and Tourist Information Centres within the Heart of Kent region. This list will also be displayed on the Council's website at www.tmbc.gov.uk. News releases will also be distributed to the local media nearer the time.
- 1.3.6 All venues/properties which completed forms and returned them by 5 May will be included in the national advertising campaign in the Guardian newspaper. If forms had not been received by that deadline, the venue will still be advertised on the Civic Trust's website.
