# Provision of Crime Figures

## Old system:

- PCSOs spent up to 4 hours compiling reports – had to read through each crime individually to exclude those not for public disclosure or of a sensitive nature.
- Previous calendar month viewed in isolation.
- Only accurate at the time the report written.
- No value to the victim of crime – very good level of victim care and support.
- E-watch provides details of crimes once a week.

## www.police.uk:

- Anyone can view the site and it is updated by all forces so can compare at a local or national level.
- Live updates on the progress of cases so anything of individual interest can be monitored.
- Standardised information removing human error and compilation time.
- Historic data and results.
- Additional details and visual crime maps.
- Empowers Parish Councils to take what data interests them.
- See crimes that happen just outside parish boundaries.
- Data is about 6 weeks behind but combined with e-watch provides Parish Councils with autonomy and control of their own information collation.
