**1 POST IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW – ANGEL LANE CAR PARK SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS**

**Summary**

**This report is a capital scheme post implementation review in accordance with the Capital Strategy**

**1.1 Background**

- 1.1.1 The Management Team report to the Finance and Property Advisory Board on the 5 October 2005 detailed the background and process of Post Implementation Reviews (PIRs) for capital projects and adopted a standard template for reporting to the appropriate Board.
- 1.1.2 The completed template for the Angel Lane Car Park Safety Improvements is attached at **Annex 1**. This was a relatively modest project with clear targets and serves well as the first PIR to be put forward following the introduction of the rejuvenated process.
- 1.1.3 After consideration by this Board the review will be shared with a wider audience via the Council's website.
- 1.1.4 The intended timing of PIRs is determined at the List C Assessment stage of each project. At the next meeting of the Board I intend to bring several more PIRs to bring the reporting on Planning & Transportation capital schemes up to date.
