Scheme	Description
Leybourne Way Crossing	<p>Construction of a toucan crossing at the Leybourne Way – Gighill Road junction to create safe access to Leybourne Lakes Country Park from Larkfield for pedestrians and cyclists.</p> <p>The lights have recently been commissioned and the Borough Council contribution will be passed over shortly.</p>
Tonbridge Central Area Action Plan – Traffic Modelling	Traffic modelling studies to support the TCAAP and to create a tool for assessing the impact on the local highway network of individual schemes as these come forward.
Speedwatch	‘Pump-priming’ funds to assist Parish Councils with purchase of speed measuring equipment and safety apparel.
Pembury Road crossing	Remodelling of the crossing layout to address current safety issues.
Rochester Road, Aylesford – railings	Replacement of unsightly railings along the stream-side. Works will need to be coordinated with the Aylesford flood defence scheme mentioned earlier in the report.
