Timetable Proposals for December 2008: Off peak Redhill – Tonbridge services

January 2008

1. Introduction

As a result of the Brighton Main Line Route Utilisation Strategy (RUS) implementation, significant timetable changes are planned for the Southern route from December 2008.

An earlier document - 'Brighton Main Line Route Utilisation Strategy, Timetable Proposals for December 2008 - Stakeholder Consultation' – outlined the proposed timetable and stakeholder comments were invited by 31 December 2007.

Section 6 of the document proposed peak time services between Redhill and Tonbridge. It also noted "off peak, standard hour services may change though details are yet to be determined. Stakeholders will be able to comment on any proposed changes to the off peak service at a later date".

Please see below, details of the proposed off peak service.

2. Off peak Redhill - Tonbridge services

It is proposed to replace the hourly trains between London Bridge and Tunbridge Wells, and between Tunbridge Wells and Horsham with hourly trains between Redhill and Tonbridge, and direct trains between London Bridge and Horsham.

Together with the existing London Bridge - Horsham train service, this proposal doubles the frequency (to half-hourly) from London Bridge, Norwood Junction, East Croydon, Purley, Coulsdon South and Merstham to Horley, Gatwick Airport, Three Bridges, Crawley, Ifield, Littlehaven and Horsham.

This proposal removes direct trains from the Tonbridge line to both Gatwick Airport and London Bridge, and reduces the train service between Tonbridge and Redhill to one train per hour.

It provides half-hourly direct trains between Purley, Coulsdon South, Merstham and Gatwick Airport, and improved connections between Gatwick Airport and the Caterham and Tattenham Corner branches.
