Summary

This report updates Members on progress with the Kent Better Homes Active Lives partnership which will see seven units of supported housing for people with a learning disability constructed in the borough.

1.1 Report

- 1.1.1 The scheme will provide seven units of supported accommodation for people with a learning disability. The scheme will be called 'Watercress Court'.
- 1.1.2 The project is now officially underway following the Council's endorsement and release of the Back to Back Agreement on 5 October 2007.
- 1.1.3 According to the construction programme works are scheduled to start on site in July 2008 with an operational commencement date in August 2009.
