1.1 Homes & Community Agency - Single HomeBuy Agent Discussion Paper

- 1.1.1 Currently the Homebuy Agent service is provided on a regional basis, with Moat Homes being the Homebuy Agent for the south east. The Homes & Communities Agency's (HCA) discussion paper outlined their thinking on the future of the Homebuy Agent role and how a future service can be designed to provide better value for money and be more locally responsive. The HCA suggest that this can best be achieved through moving from a regional model to the appointment of a single agent for England, and propose to implement this for the 2012-15 period. Through the publication of the paper the HCA hoped to encourage a discussion with partners to shape a future service.
- 1.1.2 The consultation was aimed primarily at local authorities and housing associations. There was not a formal consultation process connected to the ideas put forward by the HCA, the Paper simply asked for any comments to be returned to them by 6 May 2011.
