#### **NOTE 1**

This publication provides information on the total municipal waste in the Kent CC authority area. This includes waste (both recycled and non-recycled) that is not classified as household waste; either because it was collected as part of a commercial waste operation or because the material is not currently considered as household waste (even though it derived from a household) e.g. plasterboard, soil, rubble etc. Therefore Kent's household waste sent for reuse, recycling or composting (Ex NI192) of 46.7% (as validated by Defra's latest statistics), is calculated using a subset of the total tonnage data provided within this publication.

#### **NOTE 2**

For this financial year, some dry-recycling tonnage from the 13 Kent councils was processed through Materials Recycling Facilities (MRFs) or with companies who may send their feedstocks abroad (e.g. wood for biomass). The KRP thanks Viridor Waste Kent Ltd, Veolia ES Cleanaway (UK) Ltd and Countrystyle Recycling Ltd for the provision of information to us about the countries of end destination of their outputs. The KRP is very grateful for the co-operation shown.

#### **NOTE 3**

On the basis of industry experience for tonnages via charities, we have allocated tonnages 'abroad'. This includes items (e.g. clothes) that are collected by UK based charities and re-used by people in other countries.

#### **NOTE 4**

Waste Data Flow publishes information for 'Kent County Council' even though this is an amalgamation of all 13 Kent councils' information. Thus, the information for Kent Resource Partnership on pages 5 to 15 also incorporates all tonnages for Kent County Council.

#### **Note 5**

Every effort has been made to ensure the figures in this publication are correct. However, as the figures are based heavily on information from the national Waste Data Flow system, factors that impact on calculations are very likely to be replicated in this publication. # Foreword

On behalf of the Kent Resource Partnership (KRP), we are pleased to publish our Materials End Destinations for 2017/18. Latest analysis reflects the 13 Kent councils' sustained performance over the last five years, in terms of both how and where waste resource is processed.

Firstly, 46.7% of Kent's waste collected from households was sent for reuse, recycling or composting; an improvement of 0.4 percentage points compared to the previous year. With the continued commitment and support of our residents and our Partnership's councils, we remain confident of achieving 50% by 2020.

Secondly, we are proud to report that just 1.1% of Kent's municipal waste was sent to landfill; a staggering reduction of 17.1 percentage points from 18.2% landfilled in 2013/14. This is especially positive for Kent, given that England's county average for 2017/18 was 14.9%. As well as maximising the value of the resources collected, providing the best possible value for money for Kent taxpayers, it also reduces our environmental impact by minimising the greenhouse gas emissions created from landfill treatment. Pages 40 to 52 illustrate the five year journey for the 13 Kent councils.

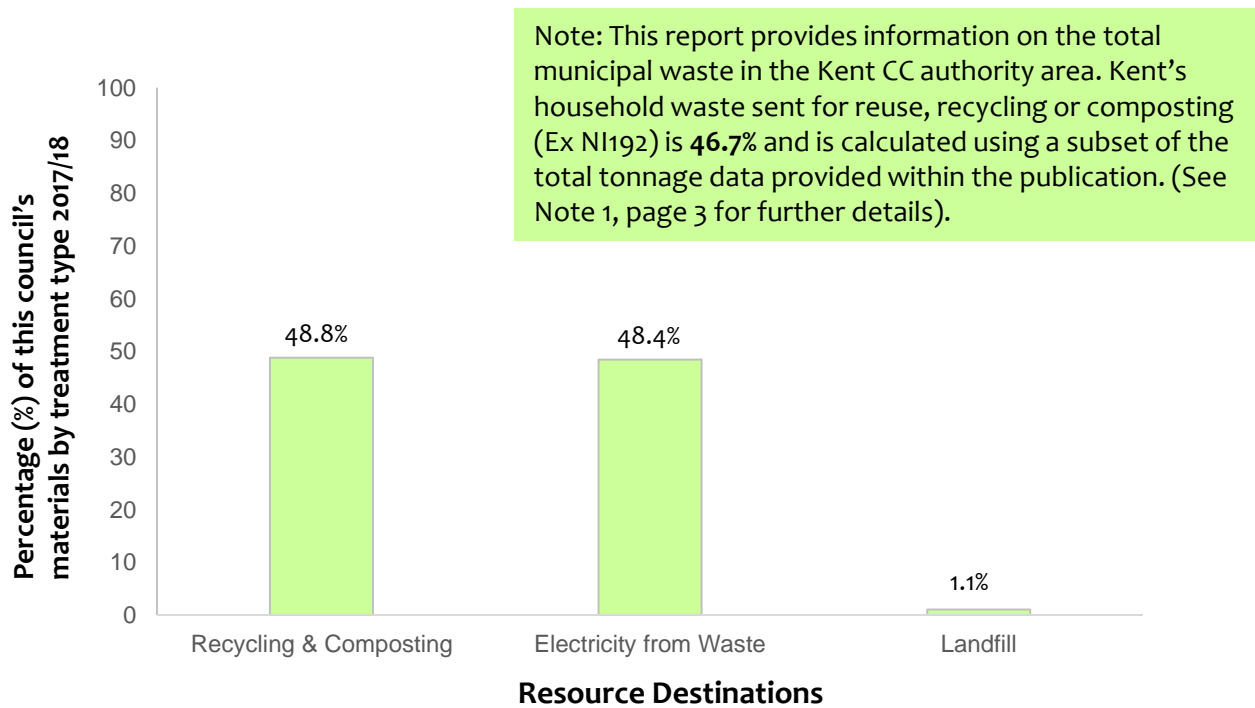
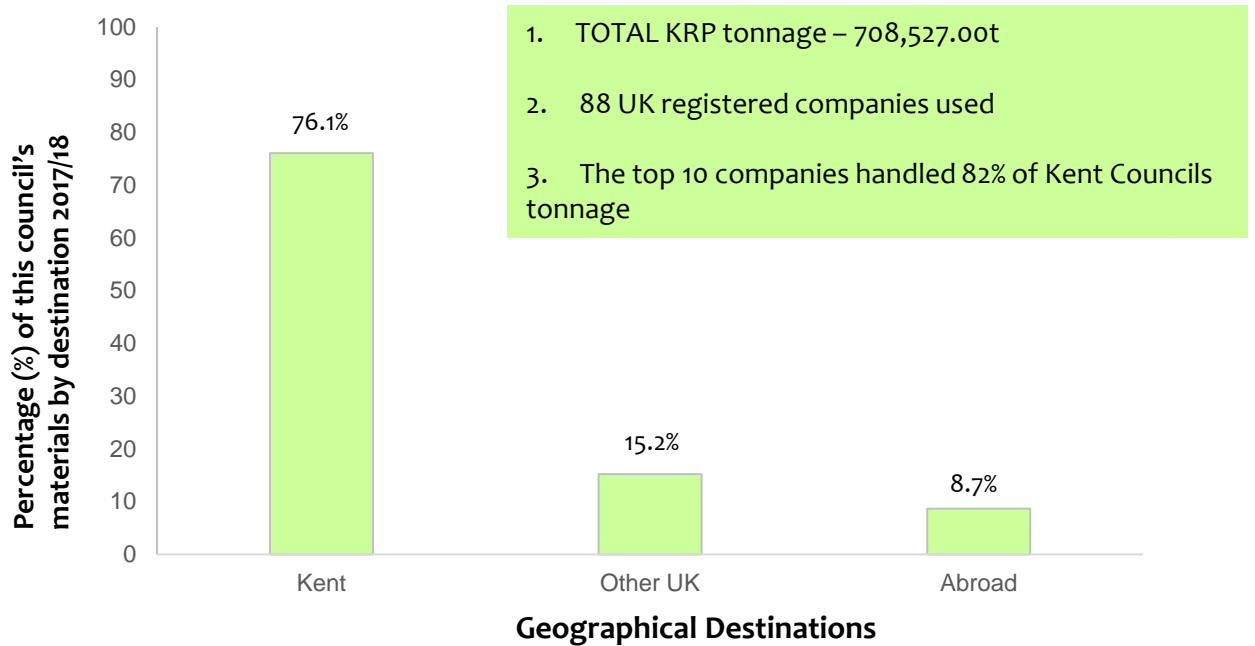
And thirdly, the total municipal waste collected was down to just under 709,000 tonnes, a decrease of 3% from the previous year. Over three quarters of this total was processed here in Kent, 15% was processed in other parts of the UK, and less than 9% was sent abroad for further treatment.

We would like to thank the KRP's Manager, Paldeep Bhatti, and Projects Officer, Kate McCall, as well as Kent County Council's, Nichola Hood and Ben Frier, for their valuable work to produce this publication. We are also grateful for the continued co-operation from waste management companies Countrystyle, Veolia, and Viridor. We believe openness and transparency about where our waste goes helps Kent's councils maintain public confidence in their acclaimed waste services.
