1 WEST KENT PARTNERSHIP - MINUTES

To highlight the matters arising from the meeting of the West Kent Partnership meeting held on the 27th April 2018.

1.1 Matters Addressed

- 1.1.1 Minutes of the West Kent Partnership held on 27th April 2018 are attached as Annex 1 to this report.
- 1.1.2 The key matters addressed at the meeting included the following:
 - A presentation from operators of Gatwick Airport.
