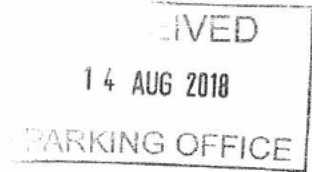



I live at [REDACTED] Dickens Drive and am in favour of this proposal.

I park my car in the garage at Tyler Close and work nights from Wednesday to Saturday. Most nights and the following morning I find cars are parked either just past the corner or in some occasions over the path and directly on the corner of Tyler Close and Howard Rd. This is not only inconvenient to get around but dangerous if there are any oncoming vehicles as we cannot see each other. Also just before the corner of Dickens Drive and Howard Road people are parking on the wrong side of the road and as this is a blind bend it is very dangerous and there have been a few near misses. If a child walked across the road at that point they could be seriously injured or even killed.

This request for Double Yellow Lines is to also give the police a reason to move said vehicles as at present there is no legal reason for them to do so.

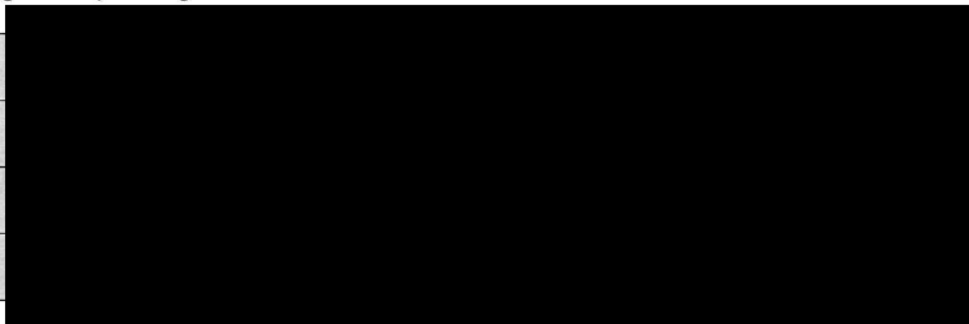


