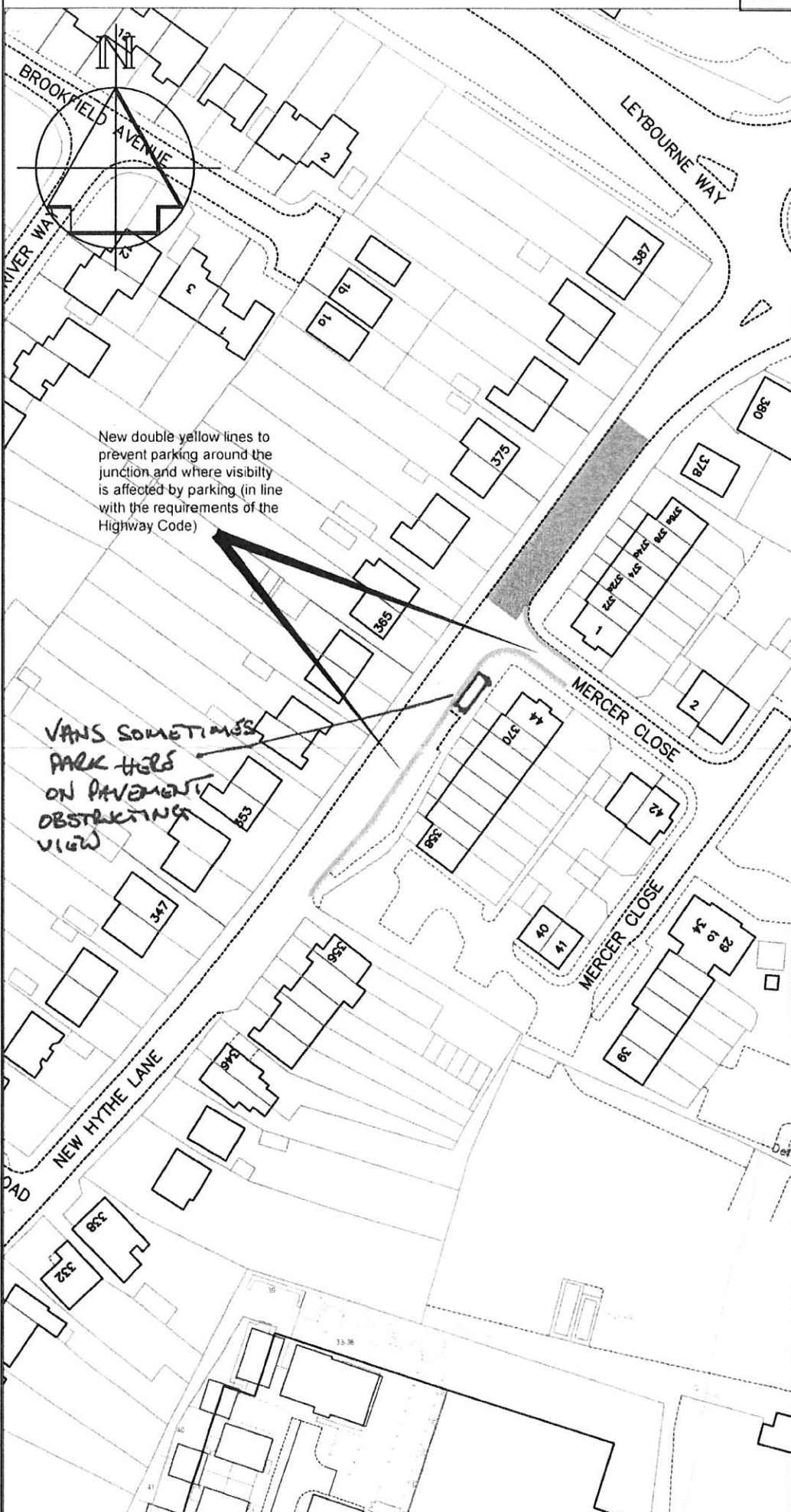
Hi Andy,

The main problem is not only cars and vans parking on the road which is causing the problem but the cars and vans parking on the pavement which is causing the view to be blocked from the traffic coming down New Hythe Lane.
