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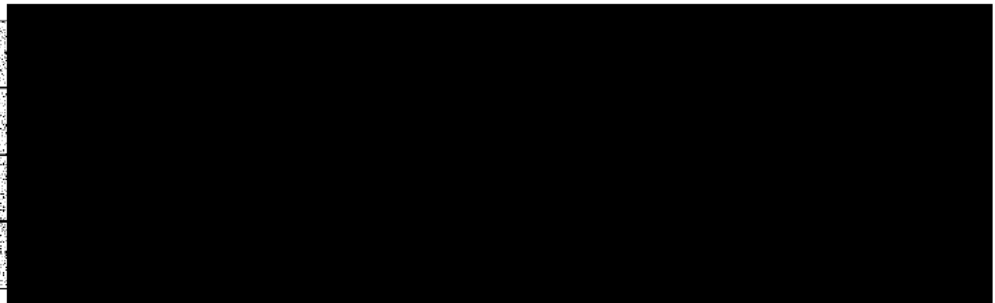

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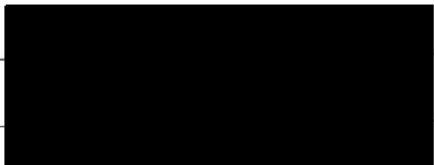

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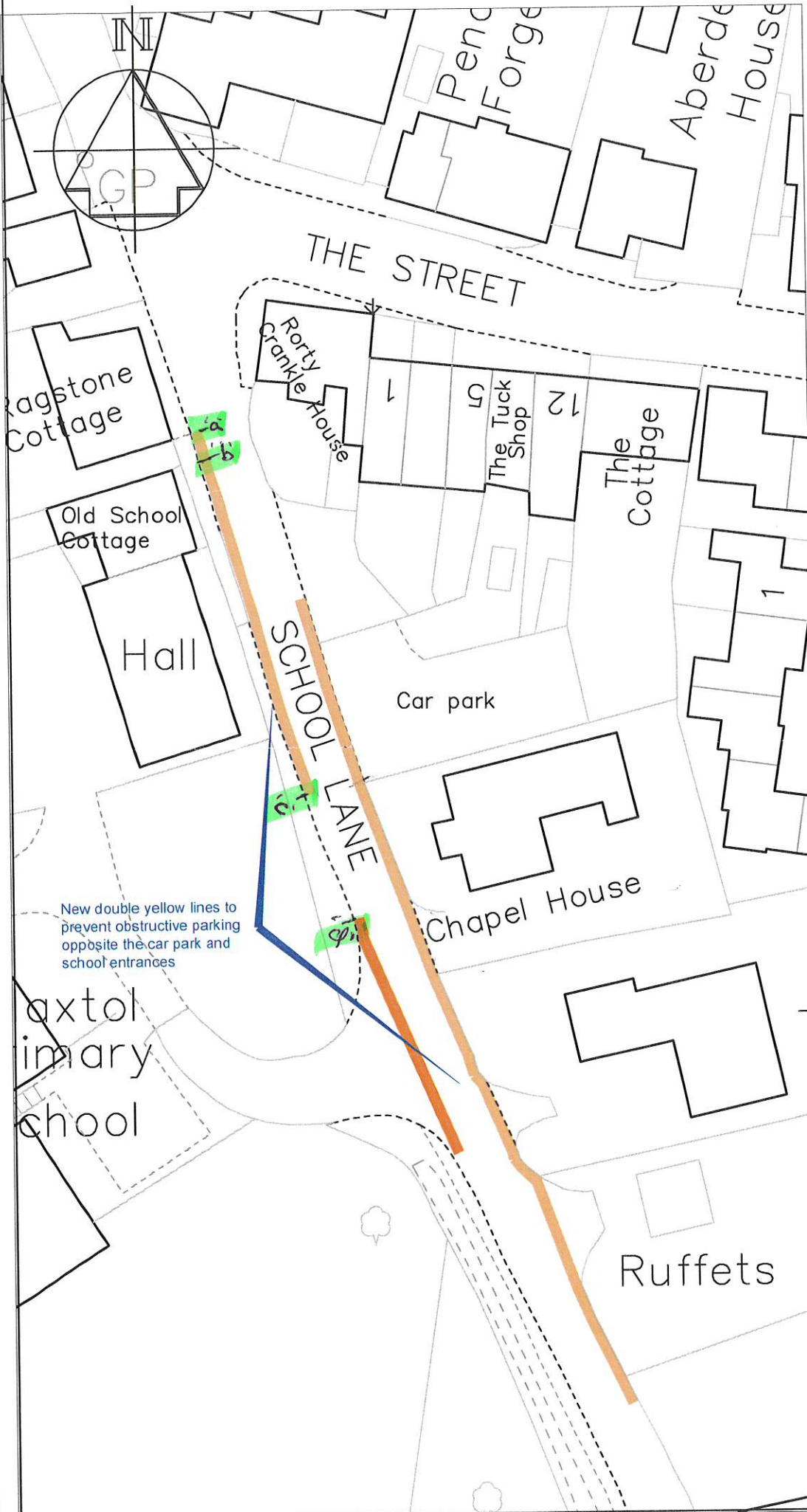

We are

We are

supportive of traffic control in school lane, however we are not in favour of the current proposed restrictions shown in plan reference DD/583/4. Our comments/queries are set out below.

- i, the proposed "No waiting at any time" (double yellow lines) currently shows the restriction in front of our property where we take frequent deliveries including Oil, logs and other items we cannot get through the front door. It is the only place on our property to access our fuel tank. We derive beneficial use from being able to park at this point. We would request that the restriction stops at position marked "b" (see attached plan) rather than "a".
- ii, has consideration been given to how cars will enter/exit the car park opposite the village hall. It seems sensible that the double yellow restriction should continue from point "c" to point "d" (see attached plan) to allow enough space for cars to turn into this car park.
- iii, has any consideration been given to where cars displaced by this restriction will now go? As local residents we note that school parents will park as close as they can to the school and this sometimes means they park inappropriately and frequently disregard local residents' amenity.
- iv, How will double yellow line restrictions be monitored and enforced.
- v, Will the school provide guidance and instruction to parents on this restriction.
