| Ashford Borough Council | We do use TPC for road closures in the Borough of <br> Ashford, for the sorts of events that you have outlined. |

| Canterbury City Council | We use the TPCA for parades and processions once we <br> have had agreement form Kent Police. There have been <br> some queries around whether it should be used for certain <br> events like Race for Life and street parties this year <br> however both of those have gone through KCC's TTRO. <br> We are planning to use TPCs for the district's upcoming <br> Remembrance events. |
| Folkestone and Hythe <br> District Council | We do recognise the difficulty Kent Police have enforcing <br> the TPCA 1847, and once an event exceeds a certain size <br> or the roads being closed are of an important nature to the <br> surrounding road network, the TPCA 1847 is no longer <br> sufficient for the purpose of closing roads to protect the <br> event and we ask the event organiser to request a <br> Temporary Traffic Regulation Order from KCC. |
| Gravesham Borough Council | At Gravesham we do use the TPCA for road closures to <br> assist with safety considerations. Whilst we seek to be as <br> flexible as possible, we do need to demonstrate that their <br> purpose is for one or more of the stated reasons in s21 - <br> public rejoicing, procession or illumination or <br> 'thronging'. Examples of their use include, St George's <br> day and other processions, Remembrance Parades, <br> Festivals, etc. |
| Sevenoaks District Council | Sevenoaks District Council uses the TPCA for road <br> closures required for the purposes specified in Section 21, <br> with the approval of the highway authority, Kent County <br> Council and the Police, through our SAG meetings. This <br> includes for parades and processions held on the public <br> highway, such as remembrance day and bonfire night, and <br> for illumination events, such as Christmas light switch-ons. <br> For road closures required other events, KCC would make <br> a TTRO. |
| Tunbridge Wells Borough <br> Council | TWBC do still issue TPCA's for smaller community events <br> such as markets and parades. |
