

Facing the Challenge KCC Transformation Programme timeline



The progress so far

- All phase 1 milestones achieved
- Phase 1 reviews to proceed to full business case
- Working with Phase 1 services to coordinate handover
- Recommendations for Phase 1 Service Reviews have been endorsed by County Council - May 2014

Various alternative business models have been taken forward to Full Business Case including:

- Trust Vehicle
- Joint Venture Organisation
- LATCo

Phase 2 Reviews

The service review and market engagement process will focus on working with the services to find out:

- what outcomes are needed
- what is currently achievable within the service
- what options are available in-house to optimise delivery

The next stage will focus on engaging with the market to see whether there are any alternative models that could achieve the same at a lower cost.

The services and teams to be reviewed in Phase 2 are listed below:

- SEN Assessment, Support and Transport
- Home to School/College Transport
- Adoption, Fostering and Leaving Care
- Community Safety and Regulatory Service
- Procurement
- Countryside Access

Care Act 2014

The <u>Care Act 2014</u> introduces major changes to adult social care from April 2015, but some of the key changes won't come into effect until April 2016.

 The Care Act brings together a number of new duties and powers, as well as making some changes to existing duties and processes. In some cases existing duties are simply consolidated into the new legislation.

Benefits of the changes are:

- Clearer financial arrangements
- Better information and advice
- Improved support for carers
- Greater choice of services

Care Act 2014 -cont

Some key changes include:

- Introduction of a new national eligibility criteria..
- New rights to support for carers.
- Nationally defined universal deferred payments to be administered by local authorities (to pay back care costs later if assets are tied up in a property).
- Legal duties on local authorities to provide information and advocacy to prevent care needs.
- Statutory Safeguarding Adults Board
- Power for local authorities to delegate social care functions to another organisation, except safeguarding, decisions on charging and integration.

School Admissions – Application Dates

Secondary Schools

- If your child is due to start secondary school in September 2015 you can now apply until the 5th of November 2014.
- It is now too late to apply for the Kent Test for children starting secondary school in 2015.

Primary Schools

 If your child is due to start Primary school in September 2015 you can apply from 11 November

Combined Member Grants

- New Scheme now open over 25 Community Groups and 6 Highways projects funded since May
- One scheme cover Community and Highways Projects
- 25k per Member available for this year
- Last year over 50 different organisations operating in Tonbridge and Malling benefitted from Member Grants.
