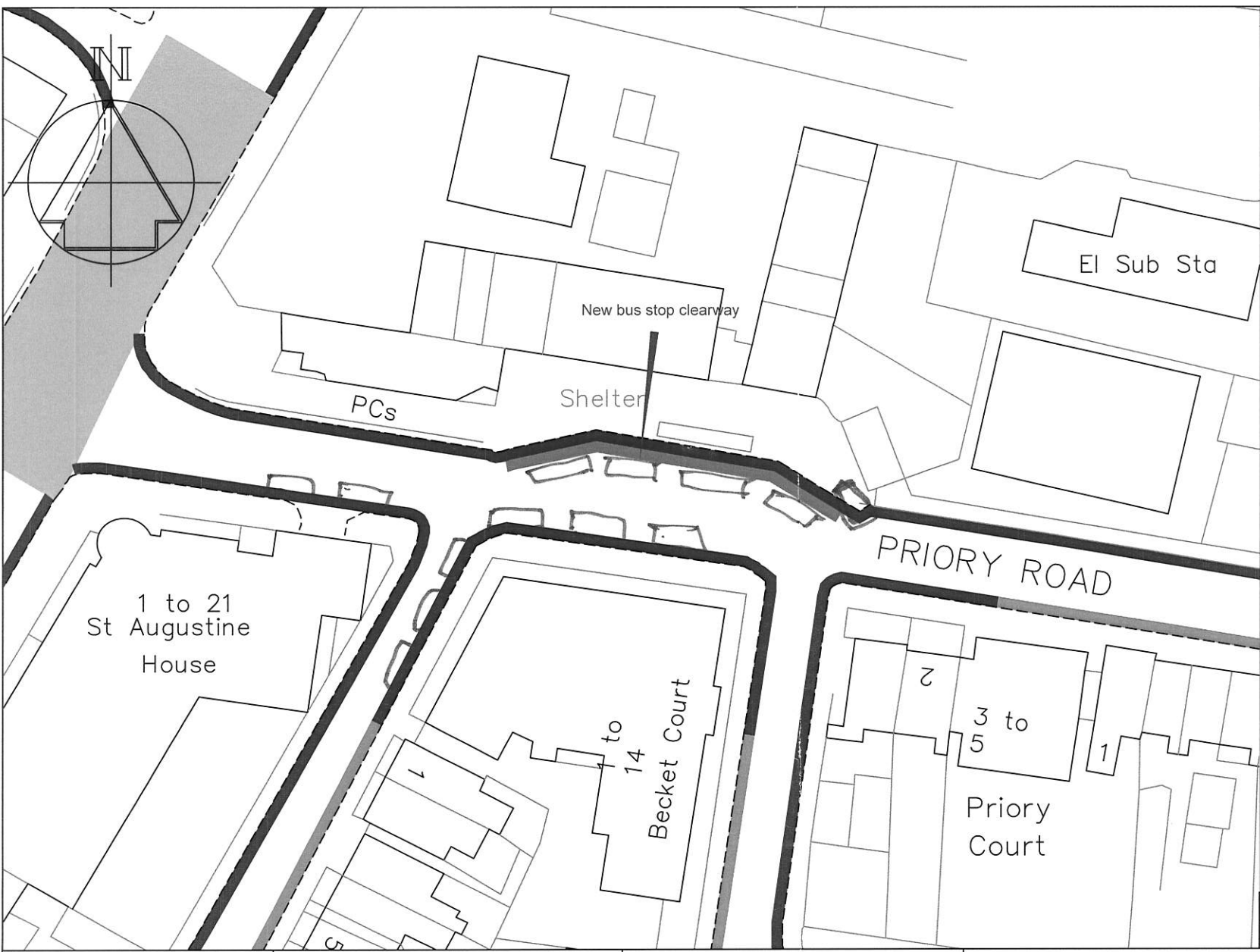

In theory I am not against the proposal on condition certain conditions are met.

- 1.) All Busses switch off their engines when stopped at these bus stops. The continual running of the engines causes not only noise pollution but also fumes from the exhausts fill the flats in Becket Court.
- 2.) Cars per examples on DRAWING DD/591/21 continually park on double yellow lines making entry and exit of Alexandra Road both difficult and dangerous. Despite numerous reports to parking attendants not much is improving. Parking illegally in Alexandra Road on double yellow lines means that often the dropped curbs which is used by residents with scooters (mobility) and/or walkers and shopping carts are not able to cross the road safely.

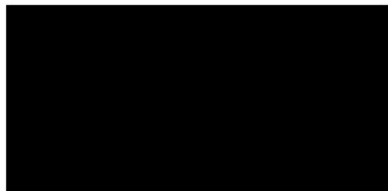

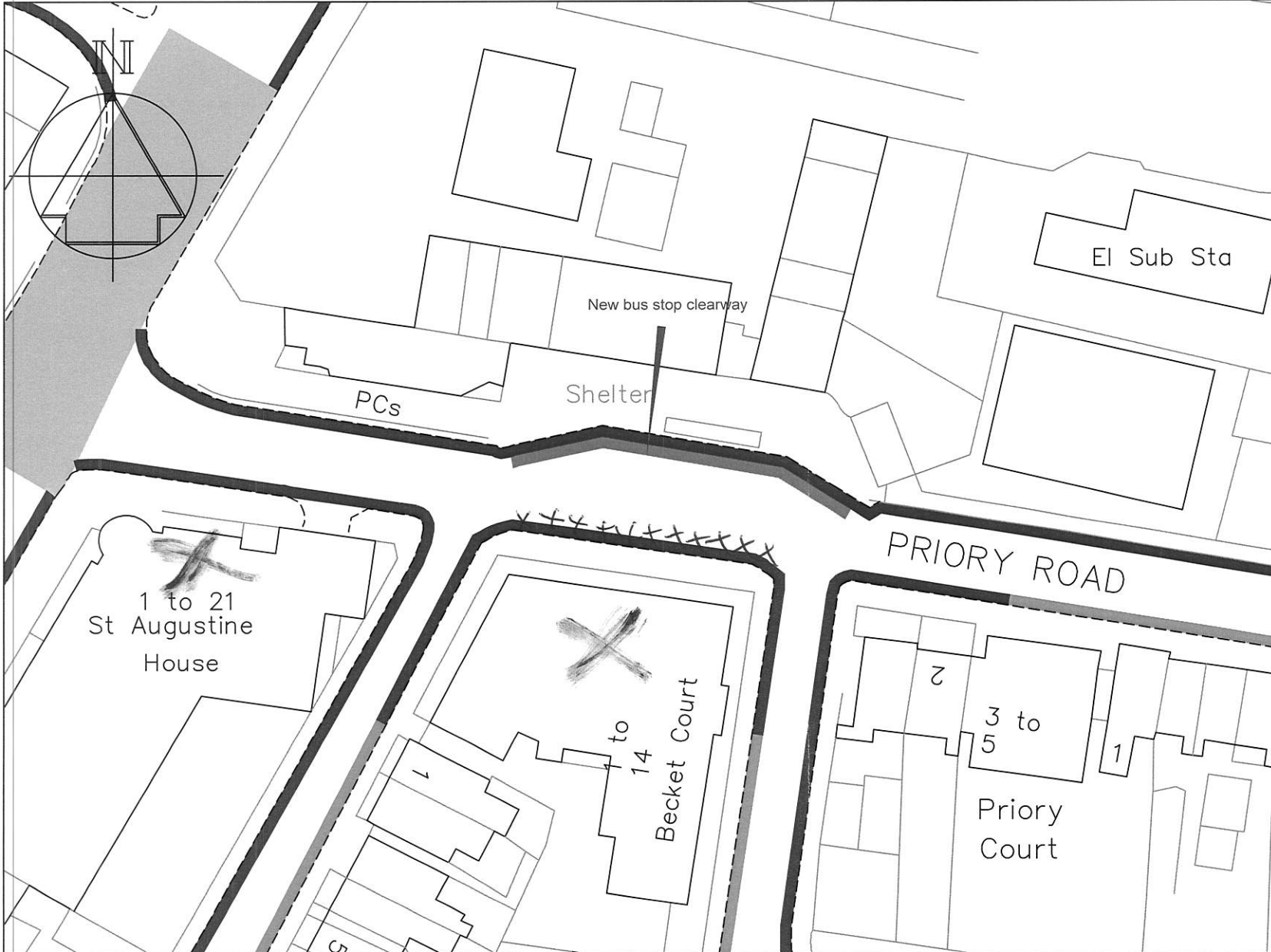
