Firstly, for clarity we are responding in relation to public conveniences located on the corner of Court Lane in Hadlow, Kent and not Snodland.

Secondly, your attached letter says; “Having initially agreed to the principal of the transfer, the Parish Council subsequently determined that it did not want to pursue a transfer.” We would be grateful if you could amend your records to confirm that Hadlow Parish Council has never agreed to transfer in principle or any other form.


Finally, and in conclusion, Council’s original decision and resolution remains in place;
