The Borough Council received a report from an Independent Remuneration Panel containing recommendations for amendments to the Scheme of Members' Allowances. The Panel's recommendations as to basic and special responsibility allowances were considered in detail by the Full Council at its meeting on 11 April 2017.

The Council resolved to accept the Panel's recommendations in full (subject to an amendment in respect of allowances for vice-chairmen) with effect from the Borough Council elections in 2019 and allowances have been increased in line with the staff pay award in 2021. Council resolved on 22 February 2022 that basic and special responsibility allowances payable in 2022/23 should be frozen at the current rate.

- Childcare and Dependent Carers allowances be set at a maximum of £7.20 per hour and £16 per hour respectively.

- 3. Principle of annual indexation of allowances in line with the staff pay award be retained.
- 4. Individual members should not receive more than one SRA (excluding group leaders).
