Decision(s) and Reason(s)
TO APPOINT A CLIMATE CHANGE OFFICER (3-YEAR FIXED TERM) TO FILL THE VACANT POST.
Following consideration of the options, the Cabinet Member for Climate change resolved that: (1) A Climate Change Officer be appointed on a 3-year contract.
Reasons for decision: Climate Change is a key priority and the Council has declared an ambition to be carbon neutral by 2030. An officer is required with the relevant expertise to undertake carbon audits and prepare carbon descent plans to reach net zero. The position of Climate Change Officer (2 year fixed term) was agreed at General Purposes Committee in 2021. The additional cost of extending the post to now offer a 3 year fixed term contract will be funded from the Climate Change reserve.
