There is a strong link between ALCOHOL and violent crime. Snodland is among the top 10 most dangerous small towns in Kent, and is the 48th most dangerous overall out of Kent's 331 towns, villages, and cities. The overall crime rate in Snodland in 2021 was 88 crimes per 1,000 people. This compares poorly to Kent's overall crime rate, coming in 0.78% higher than the Kent rate of 87 per 1,000 residents[1].

These are the following crime rates that have occurred in the past year in snodland and many of them are related to alcohol. So do we need another premises with an Off license to sell alcohol on the HIGH STREET?
