

A bus stop clearway allows for a bus to stop at that location and prevents loading, unloading and disabled blue badge parking.

A bus stop can also be enacted as a bus stand, allowing buses to remain at that location for longer, so bus drivers can then leave their vehicle for toilet breaks etc.

A TRO is not technically required to create a bus stop clearway or a bus stand, as these are catered for under primary legislation, but ought to change the TRO to remove the double yellow lines that run through the bus stop, to prevent the loading / unloading.

This bus stop is frequently used as part of the rail replacement services when there are issues with train services and there have also been complaints from bus companies about the lack of accessible facilities for drivers to be able to take comfort breaks.
