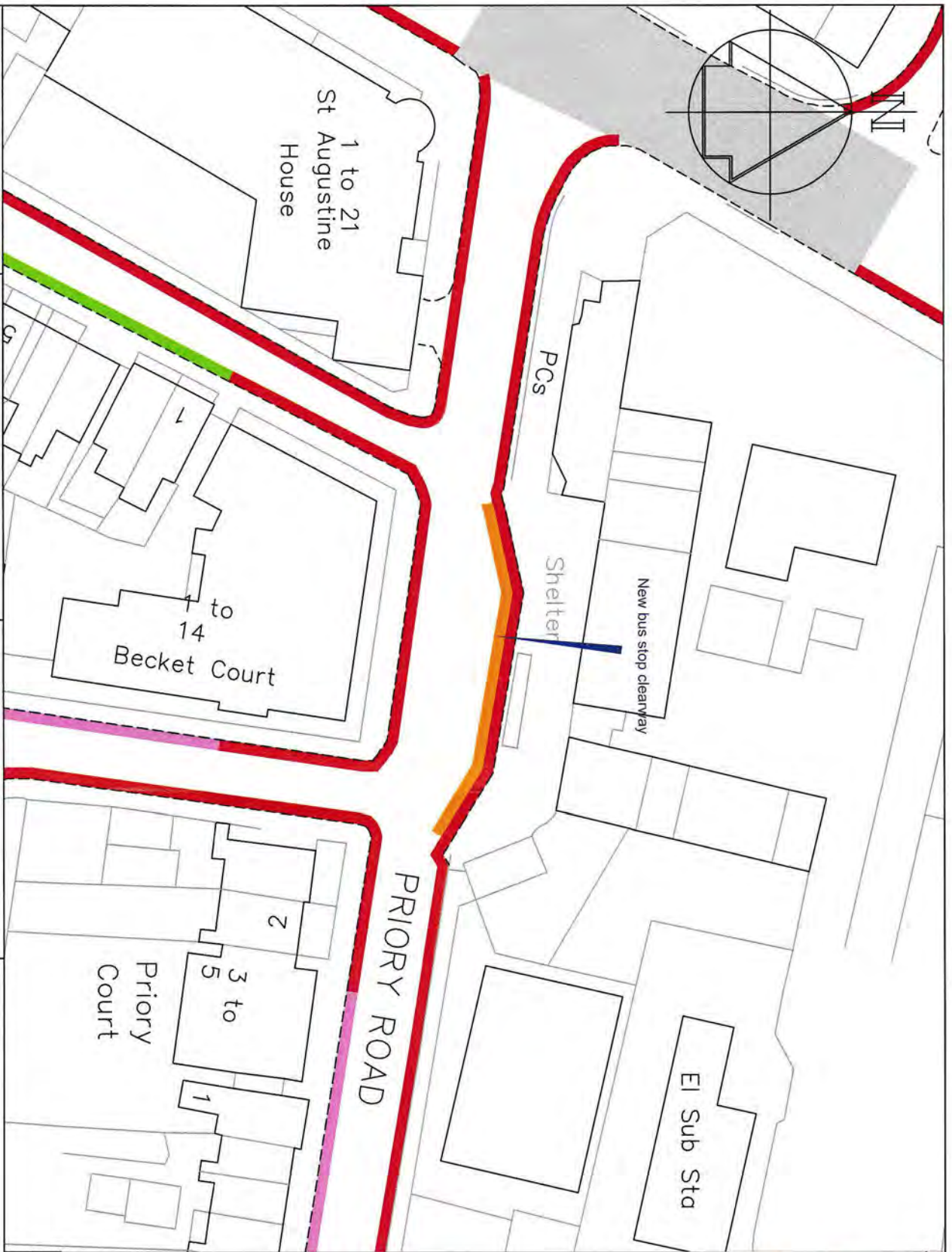

Cllr Bridge

A bus stop clearway allows for a bus to stop at that location and prevents loading, unloading and disabled blue badge parking.

A bus stop can also be enacted as a bus stand, allowing buses to remain at that location for longer, so bus drivers can then leave their vehicle for toilet breaks etc.

A TRO is not technically required to create a bus stop clearway or a bus stand, as these are catered for under primary legislation, but ought to change the TRO to remove the double yellow lines that run through the bus stop, to prevent the loading / unloading.

This bus stop is frequently used as part of the rail replacement services when there are issues with train services and there have also been complaints from bus companies about the lack of accessible facilities for drivers to be able to take comfort breaks.

Dear Members for Aylesford, Ditton, Borough Green, East Malling & Larkfield, Leybourne, Tonbridge and Wrotham

As part of the Borough Council's phased approach to its Parking Action Plan, we are proposing changes to parking restrictions at a number of locations across the Borough.

This requires a change to the Council's On-Street parking Traffic Regulation Order, and with this in mind we are now consulting on the changes to the Order.

A copy of the proposed plans, the Statement of Reasons and the Notice of intention to make the Order are attached.

Due to the size of the documents, the draft Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) can be viewed on

the Borough Council's website www.tbmc.gov.uk/onstreetcharges, however, paper copies of the proposals are available on request.

Additionally, all of the consultation documents are available 'on deposit' and may be inspected during normal working hours at the following locations, however, staff at those locations may not be able to answer technical queries.
