Restricting HCVs to two colours does has no impact whatsoever on the general public trying to get into a PHV without being pre-booked. Neighbouring boroughs all have different policies on vehicle type, colours and specification. Most of the general public frequently travel between boroughs and cannot be expected to remember what colour/type applies to HCV and PHV respectively in each borough they visit. In fact, most of the general public are completely unaware of the differences between PHV and HCV and the differences to local authority places and borough to on HCVs in TMEC.
