APPLICATION FOR HARDSHIP RELIEF

(Reason: LGA 1972 Sch 12A Paragraph 3 Information relating to the financial or business affairs of any particular person (including the authority holding that information))

Following consideration of an application for hardship relief, the Cabinet Member for Finance and Housing RESOLVED that:

(1) in respect of the application from a named business, no hardship relief be awarded.

Reasons for decision:

- (1) The latest set of accounts show a slightly better financial position to previous years and the company has no bank overdraft.
- (2) Over the last year sales had fallen, but overheads hadn't. Noted that rates payments have been made and the account is up to date.
- (3) Other requests for business rate relief had been turned down over the last few years so it was felt this was probably a speculative application to try to mitigate some of the reduced sales income.
