Decision(s) and Reason(s)
APPLICATION FOR DISCRETIONARY RATE RELIEF
Following consideration of one new application for discretionary rate relief, the Cabinet Member for Finance and Housing resolved that: (1) in respect of the new application for Babons Cancer Support, 147 High Street, Tonbridge, Kent, TN9 1DH, 20% discretionary rate relief be awarded from 1 February 2024 and time limited to 31 March 2025
Reasons for decision: (1) an award of 20% discretionary rate relief seems appropriate for the services they provide, namely providing free counselling and support to cancer patients and their family/friends. (2) An award of 20% discretionary rate relief is consistent with other similar organisations. (3) Relief to be backdated to 1 February 2024 and time limited to 31 March 2025 which is consistent with previous awards of relief.
