As an employee and a parent with three young children at Stocks Green Primary school I am particularly concerned about the safety of pupils. Too many cars and large lorries use Leigh Road and drive well in excess of the speed limit. In my opinion the on street parking actually slows the traffic down and makes it much safer. This is particularly important as there are no traffic lights, zebra crossings or lollipop provisions. I accept that there can be dangerous parking on the road but existing restrictions if properly monitored and enforced would be more than sufficient to resolve this.

In addition many parents travel a significant distance to school (in excess of a mile) despite it being their allocated school (often not first or second choice). This is a significant distance for a 4 year old to walk. There should not be an expectation that all children could walk to school for a variety of reasons including SEND, age, distance and lack of public transport at school drop offs / pick ups.

There is already very limited parking near the school and there are several dangerous roads which may have to be used as alternative parking - Stocks Green Road, Leigh Road beyond the railway line towards Leigh and Tonbridge Road. I believe that the restrictions proposed will actually push parents to park in more dangerous locations on these roads. In addition many of the alternative roads are quite narrow leading to on pavement parking.

Parents should have a right to be able to take their children to school without undue inconvenience (especially when many parents then commute to London) and without undue concern for their children's safety.

- 1. The parked cars on Leigh Road and Stocks Green, Hildenborough are there for a maximum of 30 minutes, twice a day during School Term time. The road is not used for commuter parking as it is too far away from the station to walk therefore yellow lines are not required here.
- 2. Displacement parking will be caused. Cars will then be forced to park further away from the school where there is an increase in drive ways. This would cause a nuisance for those residents and could result in more dangerous and obstructive parking.
- 3. The parked cars by their very nature of being parked there, force the traffic to slow down. If the parked cars aren't there, cars will naturally increase their speed and during school drop offs and pickups when it is most important that cars are travelling at a lower speed to protect children from harm.

- 4. The impact on those with disabilities and young children, pregnant women! Families will be forced to park further away and walk for longer journeys with young children. Not all disabilities allow a blue badge but some are required to park close to the school to ensure their safety and wellbeing. Having yellow lines and restrictive parking will have a negative impact on these people and disproportionately force them to park further away.
- 5. Not everyone lives close enough to walk to school. Some parents, I included, have to drive my children to school before having to drive onto work. I have no option but to park by the school. The enforcement of yellow lines would cause more chaotic parking. Additional yellow lines and restrictive hours of parking would have an impact on many working parents by adding on extra time for their journeys.
- 6. Although there is a staff car park this is for the use of the school only. There is also a Pre-School on both sites who do not have access to the car park and have to drive to their place of work. Yellow lines and restrictive parking would impact on them. Where are they expected to park?
- 7. It is money making scheme solely for TMBC. There is no consideration for the impact this will have on the users of the school and the residents who live there. The residents will be forced to suddenly have to pay money to have friends over during the evenings and weekends. What about the financial impact on them? Where are the figures to justify and prove that residents are being harmed by the lack of current restrictions.

There is also very limited crash data to back up extra restrictions.
