Decision(s) and Reason(s)

Business Rates Discretionary Relief Award

Application received from Paws Cat Café, Tonbridge on the basis that retail rate relief had been reduced from 75% to 40% for the 2025/26 year. The application is on the basis that it is a unique place and they have many regular customers. Business accounts show some months the business makes a small profit and other months a loss.

Following consideration of the policy, the Cabinet Member for Finance, Wast and Technical Services RESOLVED that:

(1) the application for the award of discretionary relief be refused.

Reasons for decision:

It was central government policy to reduce the percentage of retail rate relief for 2025/26 and not the responsibility of local government to bridge this gap. This is consistent with other decisions of a similar nature.
