Decision(s) and Reason(s)
BUSINESS RATES DISCRETIONARY RELIEF AWARDS
Application received from a Post Office. For 2025/26, the business received 40% Retail, Hospitality and Leisure relief but the government ended this relief for 2026/27. However, the business would be eligible for the new 'Supporting Small Business relief' and would have the rates increased capped to a maximum of £800, which represented a significant reduction on the full bill. They stated how important the post office was for the local community. Following consideration of the policy, the Cabinet Member for Finance, Waste and Technical Services resolved that: (1) The application for discretionary rate relief, be refused.
Reasons for decision: Statutory reliefs will be awarded as a matter of course to mitigate the normal increase in the business rates for 2026/27.
