Decision(s) and Reason(s)
People and Skills Fund – Proposal
Following consideration of the options, the Cabinet Member for Housing, Environment and Economy, RESOLVED that: (1) the use of the remaining s.106 funding to support local people into training and employment opportunities, as set out in Section 2 of the attached report (Annex 1), be agreed.
Reasons for decision: Using some of the remaining s.106 funding through the Panattoni Park Aylesford development, taster sessions into key sectors along with on-going support will be delivered for the borough's most disadvantaged residents, creating a useful pathway directly into employment or training or onto some of the recent countywide provision, such as Skills Bootcamps and Connect to Work which provide ongoing intensive support. Funding will also continue to be used to support the Council's two annual jobs fairs in Aylesford and Tonbridge.
